December 12th – 16th: Class bees will be held in each room to determine the top 10 spellers. The top 10 spellers from each class will then continue on to the School Spelling Bee. Certificates will be handed out to notify you if you are a finalist.

Wednesday, January 18, 2017: The Rodgers Elementary 5th grade School Spelling Bee will be held at 1:15 in the cafeteria. The 30 spelling finalists will compete for the "Top Spot". Family and friends are welcome to attend (no younger children please, as this can become very distracting to the spellers). The winner of our School Spelling Bee will continue on to the Macomb County Spelling Bee on March 5, 2017. The winner will also receive a trophy, prizes, and their name engraved on a plaque which resides here at school. All 30 students who make it to the school bee will receive a bag of prizes for their accomplishments and hard work!
